

User guide for openchargemap entries

The user interface is under development and not all of it might be self-explanatory. This guide should help you.

Make an entry :


click : <http://www.openchargemap.org/app/#editlocation-page>

Enter address data :

„General Location Name“ : descriptive name

when the mouse pointer is hovering over the icon this name is shown




Enter the gps coordinates :


The Lookup function sometimes doesn't work, so please check the coordinates with google :

click : <https://maps.google.com/>

enter the address datas or gps coordinates in the google maps search field and press enter :



move the mouse pointer to the place of the charging station and make a right click
choose „what's here?“ from the popup menu, the gps coordinates will appear in the google maps search field :

Comments for Access/Directions :

you may give some short comments how to access the charging point, a link to a picture or web site with more information. At the moment a link in the data field isn't clickable, you have to copy and paste the link into your browser.

If you don't have a web site, you may register to an EV driver forum and open a (special) thread for this.

You may also put in tags like ### Hotel ###, at the moment we don't have categories for this and you can't search the database for them, but we may implement this later.

Equipment/Charging Level info :

„Connection Type“ :

Not so easy to choose, we will improve this. For a good description of connector types look here :

If you have a three phase connector make sure, that the connector has a Neutral, ask your electrician if unsure.

„Charger Type/Level“ :

Choose

Level 1 = < 4 kw

Level 2 = 4 kw .. 15 kW

Level 3 = >15 kW

„Max. Voltage“ :

In Europe choose 230 V for a single phase and 400 V for a three phase connector

Now click on the Submit field bottem left corner and you are finished :-)

Before your entry appears on the map it has to be approved by an editor.
